Organizing your documents is key. Use this checklist to ensure that you have gathered and are ready to submit all required documents at each step of the registration process.

Step 1: Canadian Chiropractic Examining Board (CCEB) Examination (CCEB)

For each of the 3 exam components of the CCEB examination, submit the following:

- □ Canadian Chiropractic Examining Board (CCEB) Exam Application form
- □ Professional passport-type photograph
- Official academic transcript from chiropractic educational institution or an Eligibility letter confirming cumulative GPA and expected graduation date (sent by issuer)
- □ Administration fee
- □ Exam Component fees

If documents are not in English or French, provide notarized translation.
